STANDING ORDER RE: SUBMISSION TO COURT REPORTER OF ELECTRONIC COPIES OF CRIMINAL TRIAL EXHIBITS

Pursuant to Policy 2.2 of the Judicial Council of Georgia's Policies for Court Reporting Services in Criminal Cases, no later than five business days after a final disposition is entered following a criminal trial, any party that admitted exhibits at the trial must provide to the court reporter who transcribed the trial exact and unaltered electronic copies of all those exhibits. These electronic copies shall clearly designate, either by file name or by actual depiction in the file, the numbers (or letters) of the exhibits depicted. This copying responsibility includes providing digital photographs of all physical evidence tendered -- such as weapons, clothing, contraband, etc. While the total submission may be larger, no individual electronic file shall be larger than 45MB in size. Counsel must confer with the court reporter to determine the appropriate format (.pdf, .jpeg, etc.) and media (DVD, flash drive, etc.) for the electronic submissions.
